

## Summary of 6/12/08 KPPCSD Meeting

Community discussion during the last KPPCSD meeting made it clear that as a Board we need to increase our efforts to communicate with our constituents. In an effort to do that we have begun a "President's Message" portion of the website.

Here is a quick summary of the last KPPCSD meeting.

Last night's meeting was well attended. Many citizens shared their thoughts on the possible tax increase for police services. Much food for thought.

The budget for 2008/2009 was passed with a 5-0 vote. Of note there was a 6% salary increase for the Kensington Police Officers, money for both the repairs of the park annex building and the construction of a bathroom in the park, in-car-video for Kensington Police cars and a new police car. The project expenses exceed projected revenues by \$433,558.

There will be a special meeting for the board to discuss in open and appropriately in closed session; the Kensington Police Contract and the expiration and possible restructuring of the District Secretary position. The date of this meeting will be determined and advertised on this website by Wednesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>.

There was a presentation of this website and some discussion of the ability for community members to post their opinions on District issues. A Board consensus requested that the ability for site visitors to "vote" on issues be removed.
